Asteroids Briede, Groom and Boda: Witnesses of the Wedding Day of Humphrey Bogart and Lauren Bacall



Humphrey Bogart and Lauren Bacall, two iconic Hollywood stars, got married on May 21, 1945, at the home of novelist Louis Bromfield, in a ranch near Lucas in Richland, Ohio, USA. He was 46 and she was 20. It was Bogart's fourth marriage and Bacall's first. The relationship lasted until the end of Bogart's life in 1957.

Astrologically speaking, the synastry between the charts of Bogart and Bacall has the following aspects (maximum 3 degrees orb): Venus and Midheaven of Bogart is the Descendant of Bacall, while Mercury of Bogart is the Jupiter of Bacall. And during the wedding day, the most remarkable transits were: in case of Bogart's chart, transit South Node conjoined Mars, ruler of his Descendant.; in case of Bacall's chart, transit Pluto conjoined Venus, transit Jupiter conjoined Mercury, and transit South Node conjoined Pluto, ruler of her 5th House.


However, this article wants to show additional aspects in the natal chart and in transits through the use of three asteroids that represents the wedding. These are:

Briede (19029) is a Main Belt asteroid with an orbital period of 3.71 years. It was discovered on September 24, 2000 by LINEAR (Lincoln Near-Earth Asteroid Research). For this article, this asteroid represents the Bride.

Groom (5129) is a Main Belt asteroid with an orbital period of 3.67 years. It was discovered on April 7, 1989 by Eleanor Helin. This asteroid represents the Groom.


Boda (1487) is a Main Belt asteroid discovered on November 17, 1938 by Karl Wilhelm Reinmuth in the Heidelberg-Königstuhl Observatory, Germany, named after the German astronomer Karl Boda (1889-1942). The asteroid Boda represents the wedding (Boda means wedding in Spanish).

As it can be seen in the first biwheel, the natal chart of Bogart shows asteroid Groom in Taurus and asteroid Boda in Gemini, both in the 1st House, and asteroid Briede in Aquarius in the 11th House. In the wedding day, transit Sun conjoined asteroid Groom while Uranus conjoined asteroid Boda, in exact degree. At the same time, transit Briede was close to the Ascendant while transit Boda conjoined Imum Coeli with a very tight orb.

In case of the second biwheel, in Lauren Bacall's natal chart, the asteroid Briede in Scorpio with almost 5 degrees of difference from Saturn, ruler of the Descendant, both placed in 4th House. Asteroid Boda in Scorpio in 5th House squares Mars, ruler of the Midheaven. Groom is placed in Piscis in 8th in trine with Pluto, ruler of the 5th House. During the wedding day, transit Groom conjoined Saturn, ruler of the Descendant while transit Boda was very close to the Ascendant, and transit Briede in the 11th House, very close to the cusp.

In sum, as in any synastry, the contact of planets and axis are first analyzed, but the participation of these asteroids reinforce the meaning of the event. Of course, further research about these asteroids with extensive data is needed. However, at least in this example, the three asteroids are placed in contact with relevant planets to clearly show the event. Food for thought!
